

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-20

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ELECTRIC CITY ESTABLISHING THE CITY'S LEGAL HOLIDAYS AND REPEALING RESOLUTION 2012-03

RECITALS:

1. The City Council determines it to be in the public interest to establish the legal holidays for the City of Electric City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Electric City:

1. The following holidays listed in RCW 1.16.050 are hereby recognized and observed as the legal holidays of the City of Electric City:
 - a. New Year's Day – first day of January
 - b. Martin Luther King's Birthday – third Monday of January
 - c. Presidents' Day – third Monday of February
 - d. Memorial Day – last Monday of May
 - e. Independence Day – fourth day of July
 - f. Labor Day – first Monday in September
 - g. Veterans' Day – eleventh day of November
 - h. Thanksgiving Day – fourth Thursday in November
 - i. Day after Thanksgiving Day
 - j. ½ Day Christmas Eve
 - k. Christmas Day – twenty-fifth day of December
 - l. Floating Holiday – scheduled by employee with supervisor approval
2. Whenever any legal holiday listed above falls upon a Sunday, the following Monday shall be the legal holiday.
3. Whenever any legal holiday listed above falls upon a Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be the legal holiday.
