

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-03

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING SEWER USER CHARGES PURSUANT TO ELECTRIC CITY MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 13.20.030 AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 2017-18

Recitals:

1. Electric City Municipal Code section 13.20.030 provides that sewer user fees shall be established from time to time in a resolution of the city council. This resolution establishes those fees.

Resolved:

1. The following sewer user fees are established pursuant to Electric City Municipal Code section 13.20.030, effective with the February 1, 2022 sewer billing.

Constant Cost Factor for sewer charges inside city limits shall be: \$40.00.

Constant Cost Factor for residential sewer charges outside city limits shall be: \$40.00.

Constant Cost Factor for sewer charges outside city limits for all other users shall be: \$55.00.

The user charge shall be calculated by multiplying the total number of ERU's as established in Electric City Municipal Code Chapter 13.20 for each user by a constant cost factor.

2. All residential and commercial rates, both inside and outside the city limits are based on the 1.0 ERU constant cost factor.
3. A 6% utility tax will be added to the ERU constant cost factor figures.
4. Sewer Hookup Charges shall be \$1,250.00 per first ERU plus \$500 per additional ERU pursuant to Electric City Municipal Code section 13.20.090. In addition, a \$25.00 sewer hookup inspection fee will be charged for up to one-half hour of city inspection time. The charge is \$50.00 per hour for any work in excess of one-half hour. A deposit of \$1,275.00 shall be paid in advance of any connection.
5. When a sewer line is capped, allowed only with the City Council's approval, the permit/inspection cost shall be \$25.00 for the initial one half hour inspection.

Additional cost will be assessed at \$50.00 per hour.

6. A penalty shall be assessed on all delinquent utility bills in the amount of \$15.00 per month.
