A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING SOLID WASTE DUMPING FEES WITHIN THE CORPORATE BOUNDARY OF THE CITY OF ELECTRIC CITY AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO 2020-14

WHEREAS, the City of Grand Coulee, City of Electric City, Town of Coulee Dam and Town of Elmer City are the operators of the transfer station located in Grand Coulee near what is referred to as the Delano area; and,

WHEREAS, the funds required to operate the transfer station shall be derived from disposal fees collected from users of the system; and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Electric City, authorizes the City of Electric City to bill and the transfer station personnel to charge for solid waste services; and,

WHEREAS, due to the increasing costs for operation of the disposal site and the requirement to fully fund a financial closure assurance account there is a need to increase disposal fees and to establish policies.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELECTRIC CITY, as follows:

1. Effective April 1, 2022, the fees for disposal privileges at the Delano Transfer Station shall be as listed below. These prices include cost associated with debt service.

\$20.00	Minimum dump fee to 208 pounds
\$184.34 per ton	Non-Compacted
\$184.34 per ton	Compacted
\$40.00	Appliances with Freon & Compressors
\$5.25	Appliances Clean
\$0.00 per lb.	Corrugated Cardboard
\$4.00	Passenger Car Tires
\$40.00	Truck/Small Tractor Tires
\$400.00	Tractor/Implements and Heavy Equipment Tires

- 2. The Delano Transfer Station reserves the right to refuse to accept any Solid Waste which is classified as dangerous or hazardous by the Federal Environmental Protection Agency at the direction of Grant County Health.
- 3. The City of Electric City will provide billing and collecting services for all transfer station accounts. Transfer Station billing procedures shall be established as follows:

Billing accounts shall be established by application only. The City of Electric City will provide application forms to the public.

Transfer Station billing statements will be mailed to customers by the 10th of each month.

Payments are due by 30th of each month.

A delinquent charge of \$10.00 shall be posted on the 10th of each month on all unpaid transfer station accounts with a balance over \$25.00. At that time a notice will be mailed to the customer stating their credit for dumping services will be discontinued if the account remains unpaid beyond 60 days from the date of billing. All delinquent accounts are subject to collection.

A transfer station billing customer may appeal a late charge or discontinuance of credit by writing to the Regional Board of Mayors for their review at the next scheduled Regional Board of Mayors meeting.

A transfer station billing fee of \$1.00 will be charged on accounts charging under \$10.00 per month.

4. Resolution No. 2020-14 and any other prior resolution in conflict with said fees is repealed and replaced by this resolution.
